#### Day 1: Arrival in Reykjavik

Golden Circle, Iceland's most important tourist route

Thingvellir National Park / Strokkur Geyser / Gullfoss Waterfall

Transfer to the hotel and rest in Hvolsvöllur

Night, photographing the night sky and Northern Lights

#### Day 3: Hvolsvöllur - KIRKJUBÆJARKLAUSTUR

Departure from Hvolsvöllur to KIRKJUBÆJARKLAUSTUR with visits to the following attractions:

SELJALANDSFOSS and SKÓGAFOSS waterfalls

Black sandy beaches of REYNISHVERFI / Lava fields in ELDHRAUN

DYRHÓLAEY protected area, home to the puffin bird.
